

GOOGLE CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENT COMPLETION AND TEACHER PRINTOUT

My Introduction to Business students took a quiz that I created in Google Forms. The questions were all short answer incorporating vocabulary that would meet PARCC standards. After the quiz was completed and submitted by each student, I printed out a summary of the entire classes answers to be graded.

I completed this by highlighting the entire worksheet by using the square at the top left corner of the form. Click **FORMAT, WRAP TEXT** (so that everyone's answers would be able to be read in their entirety). I then made the width of each cell the size of the question so it would be easy to read. Click **FILE, PRINT**, which turns it into a pdf. Then **OPEN** or **SAVE** appeared. **OPEN** allows you to first view the appearance of the file to check if satisfactory. Then **FILE, PRINT**. The complete document was printed as a spreadsheet, and everyone's responses were available and easy to read. I consulted with Michelle Logue as to different options to create the desired effects.
