

Using PowerPoint to create a Jeopardy game for review of class information.

- 1.) Go to the following website which has PowerPoint templates for various game show review games. (Jeopardy, Hollywood Squares, Family Feud. etc...)

- 2.) Download the blank Jeopardy template.
- 3.) Open the blank template and **save** it to your computer so that you'll be able to use it to create additional review games in the future.
- 4.) Reopen the saved Jeopardy template on your computer.
- 5.) In slide view mode, open the slide that contains the entire Jeopardy board.
- 6.) In the red boxes, type in your categories/headings.
- 7.) In slide view mode type your questions and answers in the blue slides that correspond to the correct category and value amount.
- 8.) This Jeopardy template also allows for the "Double Jeopardy" option. Follow the directions on the 3rd slide of the template if you choose to add this option into your game.
- 9.) Once all of your questions and answers have been entered, remember to save your completed game under a **new** name so that you keep the original Jeopardy template blank for future use.
- 10.) To run the Jeopardy game on the ENO board, open the full PowerPoint presentation. Using either the mouse on the computer or the ENO pen, click on the numbered slides to reveal each question. Tap on the box in the bottom right hand corner to reveal each answer. Once the answer is revealed, click on the box in the bottom right hand corner to return to the main Jeopardy menu.
- 11.) Score will need to be kept manually. Unfortunately, the computer will not do that for you.
