Sporcle is an electronic trivia game that can be applied to virtually any classroom subject matter. Students can use any electronic device for Sporcle. Teachers can either go directly to Sporcle.com and search a certain subject matter or create their own Sporcle. Below is an example of a Sporcle used in a class:

The above is a Sporcle that was created by another teacher. Students press "PLAY" and have a set time to answer the questions. The great aspect about this is that students do not have to hit "enter" on the keyboard. The answers are automatically entered. Students enjoy competing against other students in the class for the most answers entered in the shortest amount of time.

At the top of the "Sporcle page", there is a box to enter a school subject. Then, hit "Search". Teacher-created Sporcles for that particular subject matter will appear.

Please note that there is are apps available. The app for IPhone users is \$2.99. The app for Android users is \$1.99. Teachers can, however, provide the URL for each game to the students so they can type that URL into their browser. If the URL is especially lengthy, it is a good idea to provide a "Tiny URL".
